



URJ Camp Newman's 10 Commandments

These are the rules and regulations of URJ Camp Newman.

1. K'vod Hamakom (respect for the space)

- We are on a borrowed site, a space that does not belong to us even though we rent it. Even when the space is our own, we need to treat it with respect and care. This means being mindful of throwing away trash, using only blue tape, and making sure we leave the site as pristine as it is when we arrive.

2. Alcohol & Drugs

- URJ Camp Newman and Cal Maritime are substance-free campuses. This includes but is not limited to alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, and other drugs and substances. Choosing to have these items at camp or use these items at camp is choosing to go home.
- Camp Newman has the right to search any property on camp. If needed, we will search rooms with multiple senior staff present and when possible, we will notify campers of a search before or after it takes place.

3. Safety & Security

- All campers, staff, faculty, and visitors must wear name tags on designated lanyards at all times.
- All community members **MUST STAY OFF THE ROCKS AND OUT OF THE WATER.**
- Please do not run on the stairs and be mindful of the safety hazards at all times.

4. Health Center

- Our health center staff are available at all times of day, with specified sick call and pill call hours.
- If it's wet and not yours, **DON'T TOUCH IT!**
- First aid kits are available outside every dorm stack or building, on main campus, and in the infirmary. AED units are available throughout camp.

5. Appropriate Clothes and Shoes

- Please make sure you are wearing appropriate clothes and shoes at all times.

6. Dormitories

- Doors – Exterior doors must always be closed, please do not prop them open.
- Furniture – Please do not mark furniture or move it.
- Electronics – Only small electronics are allowed, no large electronics or air conditioners.
- Campers and staff will be charged for broken, misused, or missing furniture.

8. Emergency Procedures

- Please follow directions from all staff in case of an emergency. All campers should either shelter in place, assemble on the *Nof*, or the *Kikar* depending on staff directions.
